### ENERGY TRANSFER ANNOUNCES INCREASE IN QUARTERLY CASH DISTRIBUTION

## Distribution Represents More Than 70 Percent Increase Compared to Prior Year

**Dallas, October 25, 2022 – Energy Transfer LP (NYSE: ET)** today announced a quarterly cash distribution of \$0.265 per Energy Transfer common unit (\$1.06 on an annualized basis) for the third quarter ended September 30, 2022, which will be paid on November 21, 2022 to unitholders of record as of the close of business on November 4, 2022.

The distribution per unit is more than a 70 percent increase over the third quarter of 2021 and is a 15 percent increase over the second quarter of 2022. This distribution increase represents another step in Energy Transfer's plan to return additional value to unitholders while maintaining its target leverage ratio of 4.0x-4.5x debt-to-EBITDA. Future increases to the distribution level will be evaluated quarterly with the ultimate goal of returning distributions to the previous level of \$0.305 per quarter, or \$1.22 on an annual basis, while balancing the partnership's leverage target, growth opportunities and unit buybacks

In addition, as previously announced, Energy Transfer plans to release earnings for the third quarter of 2022 on Tuesday, November 1, 2022, after the market closes. The company will also conduct a conference call on Tuesday, November 1, 2022 at 3:30 p.m. Central Time/4:30 p.m. Eastern Time to discuss quarterly results and provide a company update. The conference call will be broadcast live via an internet webcast, which can be accessed on Energy Transfer's website at energytransfer.com. The call will also be available for replay on Energy Transfer's website for a limited time.

Energy Transfer LP (NYSE: ET) owns and operates one of the largest and most diversified portfolios of energy assets in the United States, with a strategic footprint in all of the major U.S. production basins. Energy Transfer is a publicly traded limited partnership with core operations that include complementary natural gas midstream, intrastate and interstate transportation and storage assets; crude oil, natural gas liquids (NGL) and refined product transportation and terminalling assets; and NGL fractionation. Energy Transfer also owns Lake Charles LNG Company, as well as the general partner interests, the incentive distribution rights and 28.5 million common units of Sunoco LP (NYSE: SUN), and the general partner interests and 46.1 million common units of USA Compression Partners, LP (NYSE: USAC).
